

ELECTRONICS LAB RULES

1. **Safety:**

- A. Individuals are responsible for their own personal safety and the safety of those around them.
- B. Rules established in lecture/lab regarding protection, working with exposed high voltage, horseplay, etc. apply to all individuals working in the lab area.
- C. Working alone in the lab will not be permitted where exposed voltages exceeding 25 volts are present.

2. **Clean-up:**

- A. Turn off all test equipment.
 - B. Return equipment, tools, and test leads to their proper storage area.
 - C. Brush off any debris from your laboratory station.
 - D. If applicable, lock your storage area.
3. No one is allowed in the lab while another class is in progress or at other than posted lab hours without permission of the instructor(s) involved.
4. No food or drink is permitted in the lab.

Availability of the lab for individual work is considered by the department to be an important part of your electronic education. However, this privilege will be denied any student who disregards lab rules.
