- 3 = Accomplished

Total 10 and above Meets Standard and is Passing.

Each standard for each student must score at least 2 (minimum) to pass.

Low score is standard 1, yet there seems to be little difference between scores for standards 1, 2, 4, and 5. Standard 3 scores are significantly higher than the others. Standard 3 addresses academic content and curriculum expertise. It is not surprising to see this score high in reading education, where there is a lot of technical and specialized knowledge required of teachers. Total average score for the POL is 13.32 out of possible 20.

There is more variance in the scores as a result of using the new rubric.

We think the program can set a goal to improve on the average score for the POL.
